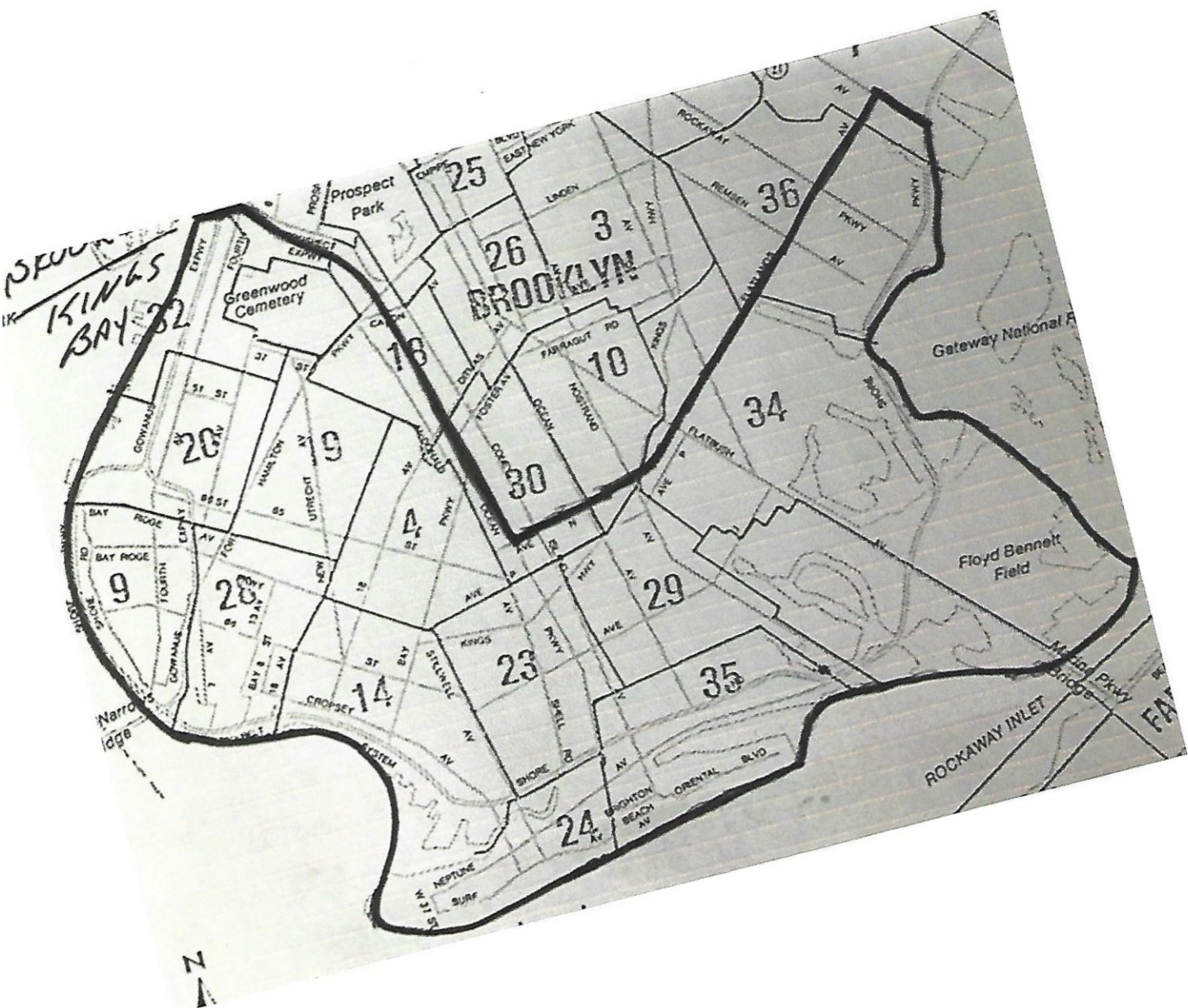

New Presentation Requests:

- Surfpoint is looking to add two more floors by late Summer and is asking for a second night of presentations.
- Presentations at the Harbor View VA will start on June 20th, with two commitments. They would like to add at least one weeknight and a weekend day. Three Panel Leaders have passed the vetting process so far.

Current Projects/Activities:

- Kings Bay Panel Leaders were reminded not to respond to shares from the floor with their own comments etc., and were requested to review the H&I Handbook and Kings Bay H&I Policy as a refresher.
- Based on discussions in the May Region H&I committee meeting, the sub-committee is selecting a base of nine appropriate pamphlets (according to the H&I Handbook) to assure that the appropriate literature is available at supported facilities.
- Kings Bay H&I subcommittee is now in-person at Our Lady of Perpetual Help 545 60th St. on the third Monday of the month, Dial in for those with exemptions (i.e. out of travel distance, headed to a commitment, etc.) provided.

Problems/Situations:

- A fire at Urban Recovery has shut down the floor where presentations are held for the foreseeable future. The presentations were moved to the adjacent parking lot, weather permitting.
- Genesis is experiencing low admissions and has reduced patient population to one floor – H&I presentations are lightly attended or not attended at all (the facility does not make attendance mandatory). The subcommittee will consider reducing presentations from the current 3 to 2 to allow for redeployment of Panel Leaders to more active venues.

Brooklyn Convention Committee Report June 2023

The Brooklyn Convention #4 will be held on August 25 - 27th, 2023 at the Huntington Hilton Hotel in Melville, Long Island NY.

We encourage everyone to register, book their hotel room and purchase event tickets online at www.bccna.org. Pre- Registration is currently \$25 and will end July 31st, 2023. Registration will then be \$35 at the door at the convention (event tickets will remain the same price).

As of this writing, there are only a handful of discounted hotel rooms available and can only be purchased through our website. Once they are gone, you might be able to purchase a room at full price if the hotel has any vacancies.

Events at the Convention include a free magic show on Friday night to all registered attendees, a buffet banquet meal before the Saturday Night Main Meeting and a Dance after the main meeting. The Banquet Ticket is \$60. The dance ticket is \$10. All are available online.

Our fundraiser at St. Thomas Episcopal Church on May 27th 2023 was a great success. Sales from admission, food, drink, merchandise, registrations, and raffle tickets plus the 7th tradition basket earned us a total of \$4,788.25. After expenses including the DJ, food costs, paper goods, flyers, and church donation we made \$3,589.14. Thank you to all who attended and supported the event.

Our next and final fundraiser will be on Saturday, July 8th, 2023 at St. Patrick's Church 9511 4th Ave. Brooklyn from 7PM until midnight. Two speakers from 7 to 8pm with dance to follow. Admission to the dance is \$10.00 at the door. Merchandise, registration, drinks and snacks (no hot food/dinner) will be sold. A 50/50 raffle as well as convention raffle tickets will be sold as well. Prizes for the convention raffle are:

1st Prize: Free hotel room for 2 nights at the convention, plus free registration, free banquet, and free dance ticket. 2nd Prize: Free registration, banquet, and dance ticket. 3rd Prize: Free registration

The convention raffle tickets will be \$10 each, the drawing will be held that night at the fundraiser at approximately 10:30pm. You do not have to be present to win.

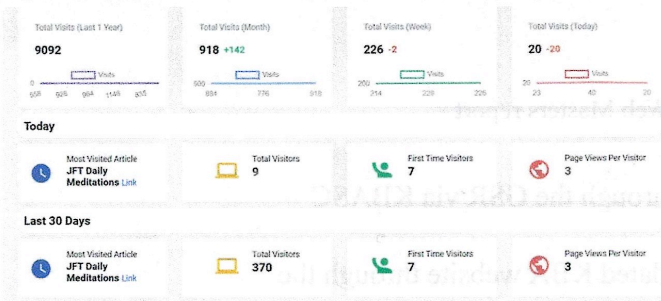
