BROOKLYN CONVENTION COMMITTEE, INC. FINAL CHAIR REPORT – Sept 10, 2026

Convention: BCNA5 was held on August 28-30th 2026 .

Committee : The committee met on site on August 27 to discuss the convention program details. The Chairs , treasurers and Serenity keepers also met with the hotel separately to review final preparation .

Fundraising : During the convention we held raffles and auctions to continue to generate revenue. We provided a free Karaoke event , Open mic session , R&B Bingo and Sat Fashion show . All events were well attended . In addition we had about 8 vendors selling merchandise Which donated over \$2681.00 from their sales including raffle items. We also had 3 areas selling registration along with the Greater New York Regional Convention and Service office Volunteers also selling merchandise, registration and items like literature, coins & key tags.

Registration : Total Registration revenue was \$14,880.00. We had over 400 room nights booked at the hotel which was well past our contractual obligation, We sold over 829 registrations, 140 banquet tickets and over 119 dance tickets. HIPIC also welcomed 71 Clients from 11 facilities . We also gave out 49 free newcomer packages from the fellowships \$457 dollar newcomer donations . The cleantime countdown that was tallied was over 6,811 years , 10 Months and 22 days – which is 2,486,337 Days

Merchandise: - We sold over \$9623.44 in total sales

Programing : We had a preconvention kickoff meeting . The topic was the history of the Brooklyn Convention – over 40 people were in attendance. There were many speakers from all over the country and some international members shared with us as well.

Treasurer: Total Convention Proceeds was \$38,571.44 – Cash & Credit Cards

Current Bank balance = \$73,968.36 We have an outstanding check to the hotel for \$34,390.30 – Which will leave us a balance of \$39,578.06 . The committee voted on giving a donation of \$5,000.00 to each area and \$1000.00 to the Greater NYC Region . Our BCNA 6 seed money will be \$28,578.06

FINAL REPORT

Dear Convention Committee,

It was an honor to serve with all of you amazing, dedicated, hardworking trusted servants on the Convention Committee.

On Friday we were given 70 registration packages and a vast amount of registration tags and lanyards left over from BC 4. We were also given a container with PI books and IPs.

The Public Information booth was open Friday 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Saturday 8:00 am to 10:00 pm. The HIPIC booth was open Saturday 9:00 am to 10:00 pm.

HIPIC welcomed 71 clients from 11 facilities. We were also given the responsibility of welcoming 49 newcomers and/or members who could only give a donation. In addition, we collected and turned over to the CC \$457.00 in newcomer donations.

On the spur of the moment, we were also given the responsibility of counting the clean time of the Convention participants. As a result, we counted 6,811 years, 10 months, and 22 days, or, calculated in days, 2,486,337 days. This was only a polling of 396 participants, about half of those present.

At 10:00 pm on Saturday, we returned unused registration tags, lanyards, and PI literature to the CC in the container.

We would like to thank HIPIC members Drew and Wanda for attending to the HIPIC table, our secretary Belinda for her comprehensive minute-keeping that kept us all on track, Kyle for his extensive skills organizing emails and the facility tracker, and Brooklyn PI Chair Alvin for his tireless service keeping the PI and HIPIC tables open 14 hours on Saturday.



What went wrong? The HIPIC workshop was well attended, and we feel it was a great success. However, the Taping Committee apparently decided it was an H&I/PI workshop, renamed it, and left the third speaker (the HIPIC speaker) off the tape. As a result, there is no HIPIC tape available.

We all feel that we did our best, but we always strive to do better. There were 7 facilities in Brooklyn with which NA has an ongoing relationship that could not send clients, or had limited involvement, due to transportation issues. These facilities are: Spring Hill, Bishop Walker, Bridge Back To Life, Coney Island Hospital OPD, Education Alliance, Interfaith, and Serendipity Women. We feel more discussion is needed to address this issue — for example, transportation or bussing could be provided (we have the resources), or a video hookup could be provided (we have the technology). This is offered in the spirit of including Brooklyn facilities in the Brooklyn Convention. Just because "we have never done that" is not a valid reason to dismiss it. More is always being revealed.

Overall, we feel the Convention was a tremendous success. We are humbled and privileged to have been a part of it.
